

ITBeurope Partnership Agreement (Short Version)

ITBeurope is a non profit association based on Austrian Law. Its main purpose is to support and promote Europe's information technology industry. It's efficiency is based on the efficiency of it's partners.

Partners (Stated as "Partner") can be

- Associations
- Companies
- Scientific, governmental or non governmental institutions

Partners agree to fulfil the following tasks:

-1 Collect and select technology and/or business news from their members/clients or other groups they are affiliated with, and forward them to ITbeurope's main office. Each partner has the right to have two news items per month published on ITBeurope's bi weekly newsletter and on ITBeurope's website. After a period to be determined these news items are being archived and will be retrieveable for one year.

-2 Support each Partner's members/clients or other groups they are affiliated with when visiting the Partner's country/area of activity. *Example: A Canadian company wishes to expand to Europe and visits Germany. The company informs its Canadian association they are a member of, who in turn informs ITbeurope's Partner in Germany. The German Partner welcomes the Canadian company in Germany, offers an initial consulting meeting (limits to be determined by the German Partner) and helps them with contacts to e.g. investment agencies, contacts to other associations etc. All other services are payable due to the Partner's terms & conditions. The extent of the Partner's free services are to be published on ITBeurope's website in the Partner country's section.*

-3 Contribute to ITBeurope's website in the Partner country's section with market information, content in general and updates in English and, at a later date to be determined, in the Partner country's local language(s). Accessibility of information for non-members is to be agreed upon by ITBeurope's responsible board member and the Partner.

-4 Delegate a Partner representative as member of ITbeurope's Advisory Board who meets at least once a year. The procedure of delegation is due to the Partner's regulations.

-5 Agree to act as ITbeurope (country) in all matters originating in the idea of ITbeurope such as events, publications or member support., and to display this fact physically and digitally, *e.g. ITBeurope's Partner in Poland is to be referred to "ITBeurope Polska" in all matters regarding joint action.*

-6 Display and link ITbeurope's logo on the partner's homepage and explain the Partner's affiliation.

-7 This agreement can be cancelled unilaterally any time, but modified only by the Partner and ITbeurope's responsible board member jointly.

-8 This agreement is valid upon signing and lasts one year from that date unless agreed upon differently by ITBeurope and its Partner.
